



Hutto Form-Based Code Charrette

In Hutto, Texas, a group of citizens, elected officials, business leaders, and city staffers embarked on a four day planning process in November 2008. They gathered to discuss how to most effectively gain from increasing growth in the fastest growing city in Texas. As a member of the project team and sub-consultant to PlaceMakers, **HFA** played an integral part in planning and executing the Charrette.

During the charrette, **HFA** was responsible for facilitating all public involvement during the charrette. **HFA** developed and facilitated opening night Vision Workshop using small group dialogue based on images of places. **HFA** also facilitated topic stakeholder meetings and public open houses, and assisted with the calibration of transect zone metrics and transect zone mapping.

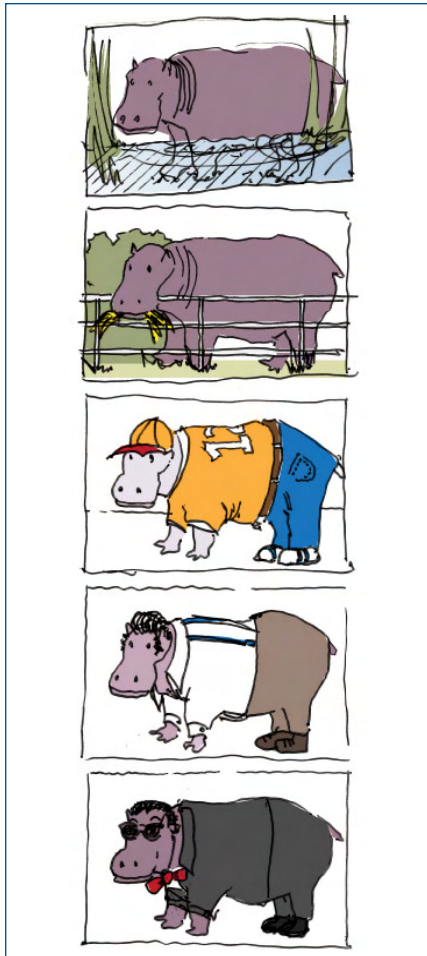
